SUEZ statement in response to matters raised on the 2GB Ray Hadley Radio Show

SUEZ is absolutely opposed to illegal dumping and the illegal handling of waste. We are committed to managing our customers' waste reliably and responsibly.

SUEZ has invested significantly in infrastructure in New South Wales and around the country to compliantly recycle and dispose of waste.

If the SUEZ brand is illegally or fraudulently used to falsify documentation, this would make SUEZ a victim of a crime, not the perpetrator.

SUEZ became aware of the matter raised on 2GB around mid-2016. Since then, we have fully cooperated with the relevant authorities and provided all documentation requested. At no point have any authorities come back to us to advise that any SUEZ employee has been involved in any wrongdoing.

If any employee is involved in any misconduct, SUEZ takes this extremely seriously and would always fully cooperate with authorities as appropriate.
