2 SUEZ UPDATES ON LANDFILL

- Received waste /Tonnes: Jan: 267, Feb: 808, Mar: 1461, Apr: 1275
- Melbourne Water have continued to deliver material Campbellfield.
The loads are quadruple wrapped and delivered in bin trucks.

3 CATEGORY C COVER

- The use of Category C Cover has been approved by the EPA. The commencement date of the approval from the EPA was the same date the communication was received. The site will now work out the logistics of managing in internal supply of cover from the SPF to negate the need of having trucks having to complete a U-turn on Taylors Rd. Truck load of cover need to be weighed at the weighbridge to determine the load.
- Environmental Management Plan has been submitted to the EPA after adjusting for additional requirements stipulated by the EPA. The execution of the plan will be under monthly external audit.
- Dust suppression is required.

4 LAYBACK CONSTRUCTION

- Last stage of 12 C complete. The zones are welded together. A third-party auditor is present through the process to assure the quality of the project.
- No waste has been placed in the last stage of cell. Waiting on EPA approval.

5 SOIL PROCESSING FACILITY COMMISSIONING

- The first of three proof of performance test has been completed.
- Cannot complete the next proof of performance test as suppliers gas pressure does not meet the demand of the facility.
- Supplier has made improvements in gas pressure supply over the last week before meeting, resulting in incremental improvements.

6 EPA

- Electronic waste transfer system fast tracked in response to various Victorian chemical fires. More updates of how the system will work will be advised. Fully electronic, utilising GPS.
- New waste regulations are being drafted. Released for public comment mid-2019.
