2 WADE ANNOUNCEMENT

- Operations Manager Wade Mosse has found an opportunity at a new business since the last meeting.
- Jody Beckwith will be Acting Operations Manager for the site.

3 LANDFILL STATS

- Received waste /Tonnes: Jan: 267, Feb: 888, Mar: 1461, Apr: 1670, May: 1750, Jun: 944.

4 CATEGORY C COVER DUST SUPPRESSANT DEMONSTRATION

- DustTreat is applied to cover and seal the area. Taking approximately 10 minutes.
- A video was presented to showcase how the product is used
- EPA requirements – Environmental Management Plan approved a daily dust suppressant, didn't specify specifically what needs to be used
- For clarification leachate is not used and Category C is not scraped off

5 SOIL PROCESSING FACILITY COMMISSIONING

- All three Proof of Performance Test have been completed
- Auditor will review and produce a report
- Over the coming weeks a summary report will be created for all performance tests
- Once this process is complete SUEZ will apply for the licence to operate
- Clean fill (no contaminated) approved
- All stabilized material should come to SUEZ at the moment as it is the only site licenced to take it. There must be an equal or better facility out of state if material is to travel there.
- EPA will have electronic certificates/ GPS system as a new duty for managing priority waste in 2020.

6 ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN

- All sites are reviewing their Environmental Management Plan
- Ensuring all emergency procedures are efficient
- Independent auditor to assess

7 LAYBACK

- Completed – awaiting approval from EPA
- Submitted to enable placing waste
- Includes a sand buffer to protect liner – 300mm
- Life of cell - 8 to 10 years at current volume 14,000 p/a
- Contours to reduce erosion
- Design displayed next meeting.

8 EPA

- Issues with leachate pumps – satisfied SUEZ are managing risks
- SPF focus on approval – will keep updated from the Development Assessments Unit
- Landfill compliance code – SUEZ involved with early engagement – draft regulations coming soon.
- Trucks covering up – Ryan spoke to Vic Roads; National Heavy Vehicle Regulator have the power to pull over trucks as the regulator.

9 ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

- Who is planning the future of the site – EPA response at the moment DELWP but could be changing. Will find out for next meeting.

- Currently there is a joint study by DELWP and Sustainability Victoria working on Statewide Waste and Resource Recovery Infrastructure Plan – Heather (EPA) will organise to see if someone can present.
- Wheel wash operating correctly
- Trucks turning onto Colemans Rd – there is currently a single white line. Is there a possibility for a double white line?
- General waste cell at Taylors Rd is a backup for Hallam Road
- No design for Cell 21
