## 2 SITE VOLUMES

- Site volumes presented.
- Everything has been processed through the plant and there is no stock on site awaiting soil processing.
- The SVJV is awaiting a its licence.

## 3 SOIL PROCESSING FACILITY

- The SVJV can not receive or process material until it has received its licence.
- A skeleton crew is remaining to keep up the facilities maintenance schedule.
- Material will need to go to a competitor in the meantime
- CRG committee would be intrigued to know how other site process soil and would like EPA's input next meeting.

## 4 SAND PROTECTION LAYER

- The applied sand washed away since last meeting. The sand is applied as additional protection for the plastic layer.
- Additionally, roads are being maintained.
- The site is enforcing speed limits

## 5 EPA COMMUNITY FEEDBACK

- Encouraged the reference group to give feedback on regulations by Oct 31, 2019.
- Noted, summary of waste framework is easier to read
- Discussed there should be a commonality between states
- The reference group would like to utilise their understanding of the industry and create a letter addressing the need for environmental regulations to be consistent between states.
- Infrastructure manager Andrew Cason encouraged the reference group to send the letter independently.
- The attendees of the meeting confirmed their emails could be circulated by Ashley Kelly post the meeting for the attendees to complete the letter.
- It was discussed that an independent chair is being sort after.

## 6 GUIDELINES POST CLOSURE

- Discussed that this is well into the future and the committee should revisit the topic with the relevant parties present.
- Solar panels were recommended during this discussion.
- SUEZ supported this notion stating SUEZ aim to be energy natural by 2023

## 7 INNOVATION: DETECTION TESTING

- SUEZ is testing a drone that measures methane using a laser. The algorithm finds the shortest path to the source. This would help efficiently identify sources.
- The done will continue to undergo testing

## 8 COMMUNITY GRANTS

- Try Australia was presented their 2018 plaque at the beginning of October for their Dandenong Urban Garden. CGD Mayor Roz Blades was in attendance.

## 9 ADDITIONAL COMMITTEE COMMENTS

- Referring to turning left out of site – Warren Wood advised that the City of Greater Dandenong (CGD) do not use double white lines in the area. It is lawful to turn either way out of site from CGD perspective.
- EPA can not enforce trucks loads on the road.

- Ian suggested drivers be given a reminder not to turn left out of site and larger signs be installed.
- Questioned raised by adequacy of wheel wash
- Notes trucks are required to cover load coming and going from site
- Reference group would like Vic Road present for their responsibility monitoring trucks
- Documentary recommendation given by Thelma City of Casey Presenting – 2040 Climate Change (Oct 24, 2019)
