	<p>SS – TRL Update Filling Rates SS gave tonnage update 40850 YTD 5112 air space consumed 1.03 compaction rate Approx. 2000 tons per month Construction update on 12C layback; expected completion end of January.</p> <p>Cat C Soil Trial Received letter from auditor – They (the Auditor) has questioned analysis conducted as an OH&S analysis standard was applied. OHS screen allows the auditor to conclude there is no significant risk to workers in the cell. However because not in the environmental analysis standard the results cannot be used to verify no environmental risk, although it is deemed unlikely. The Auditor has there Recommended to add both the OHS and environmental analysis into the ongoing monitoring program. The results that were seen were verified by the auditor, who concluded there was no significant risk should the existing and newly recommended controls be applied. Comments about dust, but nothing of significance to the auditor. SS to put a brief together and forward to the EPA. Subject to EPA approval, TRL intends to progress with this project.</p> <p>Compliance Environmental monitoring update; FID has been completed across the site. Over 238 points, 7 were non-compliant and were reported to the EPA. A remediation plan has been implemented and 6 areas have returned to compliance. Leachate and gas are compliant. Quarterly groundwater is undergoing this week but expected to be compliant MW – questioned the process of FID remediation SS – discussed balancing of gas wells and manifolds. Working with ELD. Discovered faulty hand valves which have been replaced. Some areas had depressed, so extra cover has been placed. The final area will require further investigation. Discussed the difference between HRL and TRL sites and the gas infrastructure and how this affects surface gas.</p>

No further comments.</p> <p>Does TRL CRG want consider approaching the council about the development voicing concern? TRL CRG are seeking what considerations were taken before approving this development.</p> <p>MG – with our planning permit extension, TRL had to notify all interested parties, would this include the members of new development.</p> <p>JM – to draft the letter on behalf of the TRL CRG.
