### INTRODUCTION / MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

- Invitations have been extended to the Lynbrook Residents Association (LRA) to become part of the CRG. SUEZ have had further conversations with the LRA to coordinate Clean Up Australia Day.
- The proposed Leachate Treatment Facility has been advertised in the Herald Sun, Cranbourne Leader, Star Newspapers by the EPA this week.

- Berwick Star Letter “I live in a rubbish tip” – Notion of civic pride. Rivergum Creek and Hallam Road Trail appear to be cleaned since the article published. Invitation to attend the CRG extended by Chair, Brian Oates and reiterated by Stakeholder Engagement Officer, Ashley Kelly.
  - EPA alleged odour reports – 17 reported incidents.
  - Environmental Report Hotline - 2 alleged reports
  - SUEZ announced that it shut down the site on March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019 due to extreme wind to be proactive in preventing litter escaping the site. Measures were taken on two other occasions to reduce truck flows in lesser instances of wind. City of Casey confirmed that they had to find alternatives for their waste on these occasions.
  - City of Casey addressed the SKM ban on recyclables, advising they had alternatively sent their recycling to Polytrade.
  - David confirmed the previous Glasscocks road action has been completed.

## CLEAN UP AUSTRALIA DAY

- With LRA feedback we tidied up Lynbrook Station and Banjo Paterson Reserve with the assistance of Brian Oates and Select Civil.
- Collected 7 bags in 2 hours.

## CAPPING CELL 10A

- Visually demonstrated the processes and material used to cap the cell.
- Mention of odour curtain requirement when drilling new wells.

## CONSTRUCTING CELL 13

- Demonstrated the recent processes of the construction of Cell 13.
- The 860,000m<sup>3</sup> volume raised questions from the committee about the management of the cell due to historic odour and waste water treatment issues faced with Cell 8. SUEZ addressed the query by explained this cell will have two sumps, the rate of projected filling is 2/3 quicker than Cell 8, dual purpose wells and horizontal lines will be installed.

## CHARITY INVOLVEMENT

- Casey Relay for Life – SUEZ helped support the event, providing bins and water bottles for the volunteer team members working in extreme weather. The event raised \$267088
- Australia's Biggest Playdate – SUEZ helped support the event, providing bins, a donation and fun promotional material. The event raised \$35500
